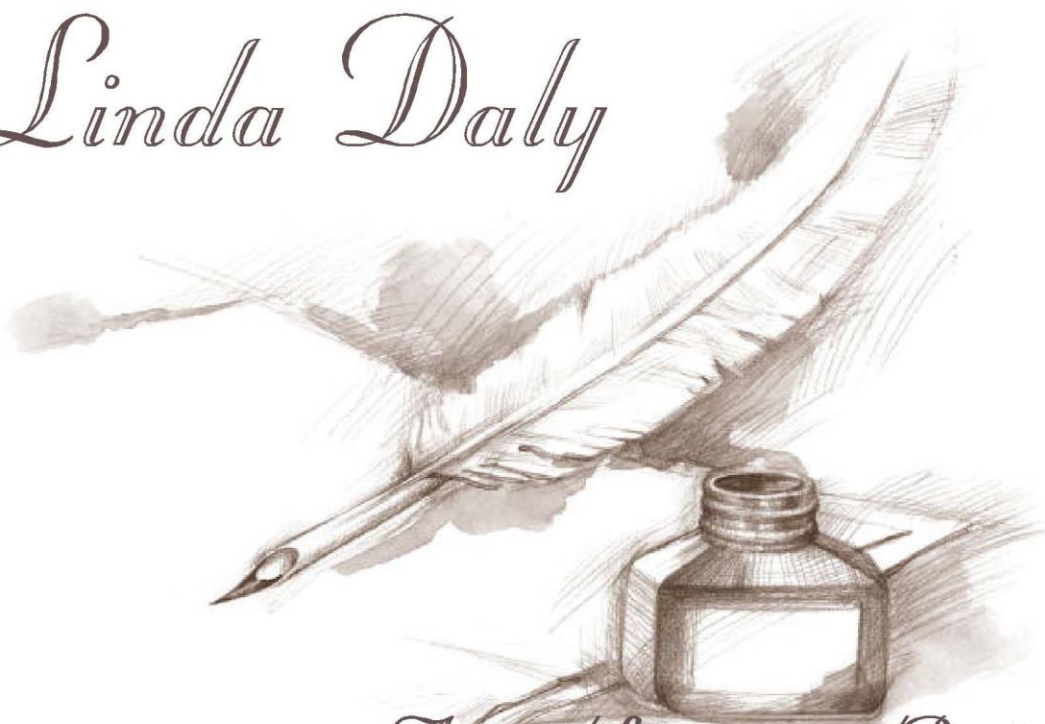

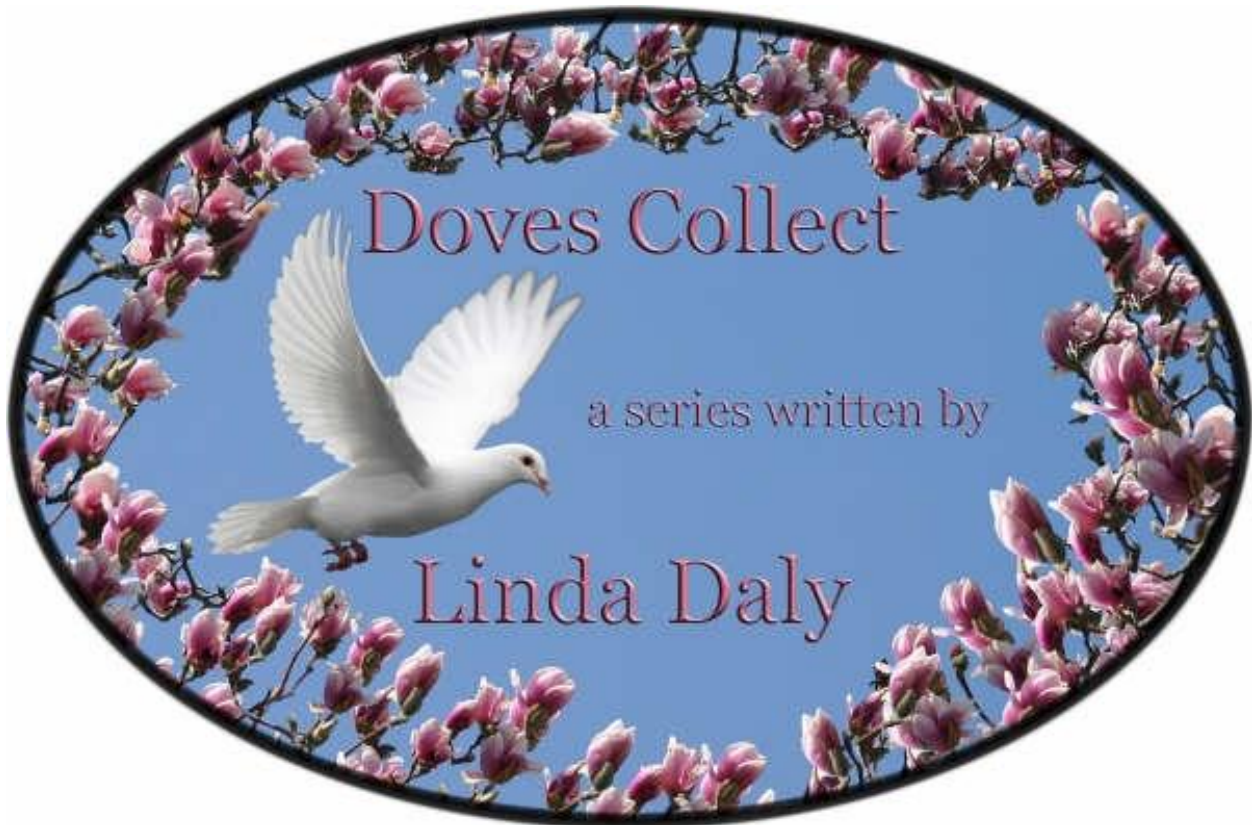

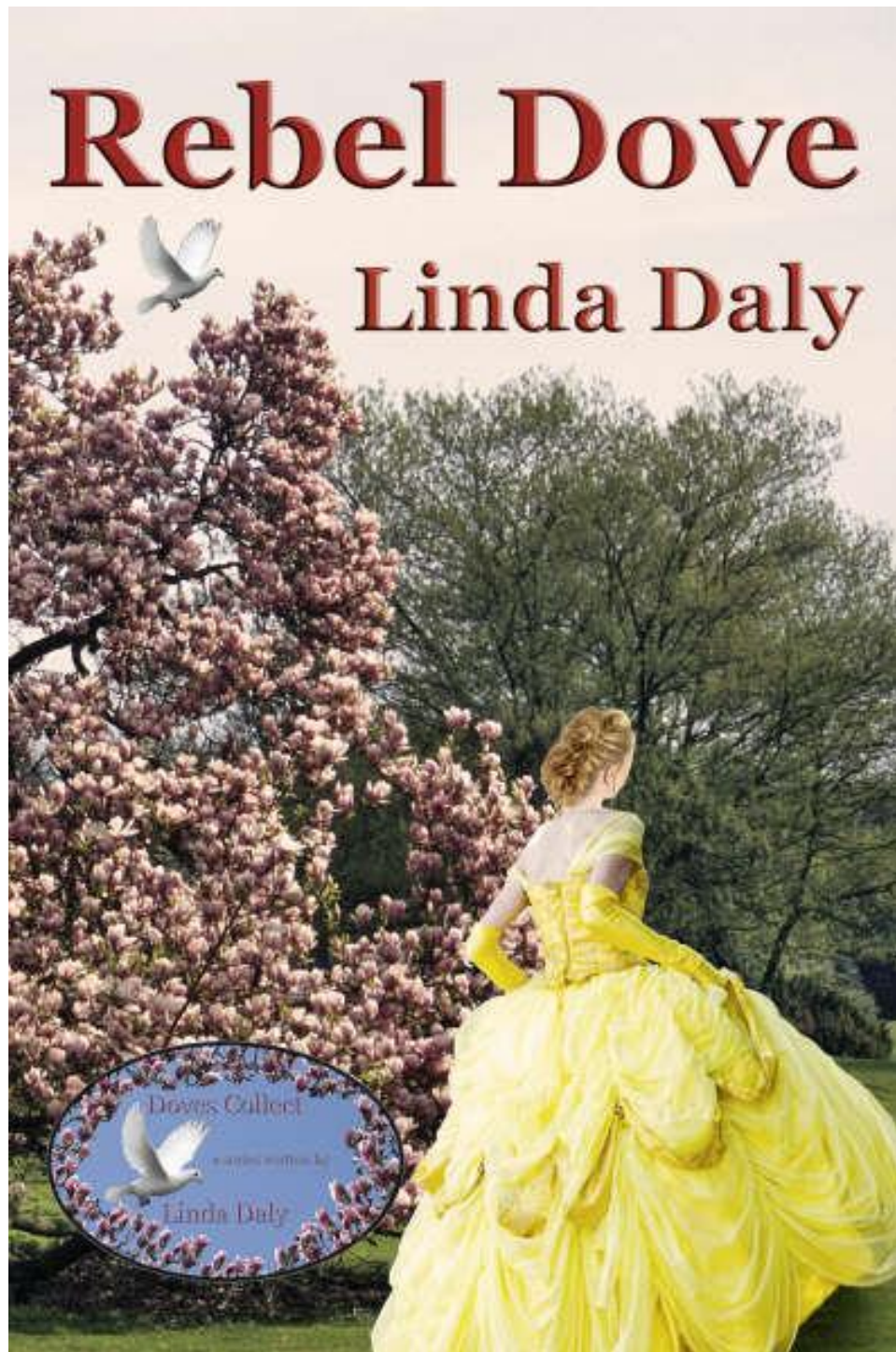

After successfully passing on the information and feeling exceptionally smug, Elise is suddenly stopped only miles from her home, and questioned by Major Joshua Carmidy. Much to her dismay, the fast talking and keen-witted Elise has difficulties with this particular Yank. He's equal to her craftiness and unwavering determination, and if that wasn't unnerving enough, he obviously doesn't believe her flimsy alibi. Cleverly, Elise tries to distract him, employing her most alluring charms, and becomes insulted when she discovers he's immune to her beauty. Adding further insult, she is infuriated to find that the 'good major' has taken up residency at Doves Landing.
